World Café – How does it work?

The world café method is very simple ©

- People sit very comfortable at several discussion tables (6-8 people) per table and discuss together one topic.
- At each table, there is one table host who welcomes the participants and remains the whole duration of the world café at the table.
- All participants (except the table hosts) change the table every time the timekeeper gives a signal and join thus a new discussion on a new topic.
- At the end, a summary of all discussions is given to the participants by the table hosts.
